

UW Sports Medicine Center New Patient Information

Welcome to UW Sports Medicine Center at Husky Stadium Physical Therapy! Please read through the below prior to your first appointment with us.

Insurance Coverage: If you have a commercial health insurance plan, our hospital-based billing will likely be applied to a deductible and coinsurance rather than an office co-pay. Your out-of-pocket expense will depend on your deductible amount and what has already been met.

In addition, please be aware that any Physical Therapy care you've received after January 1st, 2018 may count toward your yearly usage. Any appointments beyond the limit set by your insurance plan could be denied.

No Show and Late Cancellation Policy: In an effort to respect Access to Care for all patients, our clinic has a no show and late cancellation policy.

- o Patients who cancel their appointment less than 24 hours prior or miss their scheduled appointment without notice will be sent a letter recording the occurrence and notifying them of our policy.
- Three occurrences of late cancellations and no-shows may result in our clinic no longer providing health care for a patient.

Child Policy: It is our responsibility to ensure a safe environment for our patients and visitors.

- In the Physical Therapy clinic, children (less than 12 years of age) who are not patients are not permitted in the gym or evaluation areas
- If children accompany their parents to an appointment, a responsible adult other than the patient must be designated to supervise their child(ren) outside the physical therapy clinic while they receive care

Elevator Hours: If you are seeing us in the evening, some services may be different than during the day.

- Front desk staff will be leaving the clinic by 6pm after the last patient has been checked in
- Elevators will no longer travel down to the clinic level after 6:10pm (they will still operate from the clinic up to parking level)
